What you can do

- Check your symptoms search trusted NHS advice on hundreds of conditions and treatments
- View your medical record and download documents - securely access your GP medical record. test results, allergies and meds (from the date specified by your Surgery)
- View and download test results and vaccination certificates
- **Read messages from the surgery**
- Initiate online consultations Non urgent medical advice via eConsult
- Change your nominated pharmacy - for repeat prescriptions
- Help someone else using a linked profile (and proxy access)
- **Use your NHS Login for other Apps** - like BP@Home. PillTime or Airmid

What you cannot do

- Booking and cancel appointments certain appointments can be booked via a link sent by sms or email
- Update your home contact details
- Upload information to your medical record

Non urgent medical advice complete an eConsult without having to resubmit your personal info, click 'Services' then select 'Contact your GP about a health problem'
